Delivering Core Programs: Our priority is refining and delivering on our **foundational services** designed specifically for kinship families. Through our Support, Advocacy and Case Management Programs, we have improved the lives of **332 families**.

Prioritizing Partnerships: We are proud of the partnerships we have forged with community organizations to advocate for **increased help** for kinship families. We partner with Department of Family Services, Peggy's Attic, all the Family Resource Centers, Fostering Southern Nevada, Compass Behavioral Health, Car Seats for Christy, The Center for Spiritual Living, and A Touch of Love to ensure **comprehensive support** for our families.

Volunteer Driven: Over **50 volunteers** faithfully reinforce the work of volunteer founder and director Alison Caliendo. A 16-month contract with Clark County enabled us to hire our first part-time employee late 2014.

Broadly Supported: Foster Kinship won **second place** for most number of unique donors in 2014 Nevada's Big Give. In 2014, **\$30K** was raised through individual donations, corporate grants and in-kind gifts, while total program cost was \$21K.

Forward Looking: The need for kinship family support remains great. While we have reached many kinship families in three years, we estimate that most children in kinship care are underserved. As the only organization in Clark County, NV dedicated to meeting the unique needs of **kinship families**, we look forward to continued growth and success in the years to come, and are proud to serve this important population of people who **"keep home in the family"** for some of Clark County, NV's most vulnerable children.
