



Foster Kinship helps abused and neglected children who can't be with their parents live with their family. **In 2019, we served 1702 kinship families.**

In 2019 we raised \$638,753 and spent \$555,786 to meet the needs of kinship families, increasing our net assets by \$82,967 to an end of year net asset balance of \$256,892. Ellsworth & Stout LLC completed our 2019 audit.
